

HARLAN – Leola Fay Baker "Lee" was born Dec.12, 1922, to Lafe and Myrtle (McMurphy) Fairchild on a farm east of Irwin. She attended country grade school east of Irwin, and graduated from Manning High School with the class of 1941. While in high school she took teacher training classes and taught country school near Irwin. In 1943, she moved to Omaha, NE, where she began her career in the restaurant business.
