The family lived in Defiance for many years and all of the children graduated from Irwin Community School. After Detlef died Nov. 25, 1963, she moved to California to make her home with Bevery and family. She remained in California except for occasional visits to the midwest and spent two years in Freeport, Bahamas, caring for her two nephews. She remained in fairly good health except for arthritis in her later years. Dec. 28, 2002, Loena celebrated her 95th birthday with many family members present. Dec. 31, 2002, she was admitted to the hospital and died Jan. 3, 2003, with family members by her side, at age 95.
