CO. BLUFFS – Ronald Roy Bargaenquast was born in Shelby, and graduated from Shelby High School in 1956. He later attended the Electronic Institute in Omaha. He lived the past 36 years in Co. Bluffs and worked as a laborer for the City of Co. Bluffs. He was a veteran of the United States Marines. He and his wife, Mary Jane (Graham) were married 38 years. He died July 28, 2000, at his residence following a bout with cancer at age 62.
