SHELBY – John Calvin Barrett, the youngest son of Galen and Julia (Frazey) Barrett, was born on March 31, 1923, on the family farm in rural Shelby. It was there he would live and farm most of his life. John graduated from Tennant High School in 1942.

John continued to live there following Helen's death on May 1, 2011, until November 2013, when he became a resident of Avoca Specialty Care in Avoca.

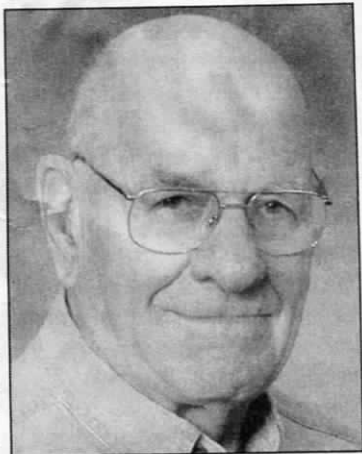

Following their retirement from farming, John and Helen enjoyed traveling in their fifth wheel camper, seeing most of the United States.

John C. Barrett died on Friday, February 9, 2018, at Myrtue Medical Center in Harlan, having reached the age of 94 years, 10 months, and nine days.
