WALNUT — Adam John Barta, the son of Robert Lee and Margaret "Peg" Jean (Wendt) Barta, was born June 29, 1984, in Harlan. He was baptized at St. Mary Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Portsmouth. At an early age, it was discovered that Adam was suffering from a form of cancer. As a little boy, he had to undergo surgery for removal of much of the muscle tissue in his left leg and removal of his left knee cap. Nov. 26, 2004, Adam married Ashley Neese. One son was born to this union, Adam John Barta, Jr. After their marriage, the couple resided in Walnut. He was employed with Farmland Foods, Inc. in Denison. He died March 29, 2006, at Kirkman at age 21 years and nine months.
