

Darrell "Barky" Bauerkemper, 83

Bauerkemper, son of George and Matilda (Wohlert) Bauerkemper, was born on July 5, 1928 on a farm near Neola. He attended Layton Township Country School and graduated from Walnut High School at the age of sixteen. While growing up, Darrell helped his father on the family farm. Darrell died Sunday, March 25, 2012 at the Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic, having attained the age of eighty-three years, eight months and twenty days.
