

Urbandale woman killed in I-80 crash

SHELBY -- A 23-year-old Urbandale woman was killed in an accident along Interstate 80 near the Shelby exit Monday, Feb. 4.

Carly Elizabeth Behncke died from injuries sustained in the accident, according to the Iowa State Patrol.

Reports said Behncke was eastbound in a 2002 Mercury Cougar when her vehicle

veered out of control due to icy conditions on the roadway.

The vehicle spun into the median and then continued into the westbound lanes of I-80, where it was hit on the passenger side by a semitrailer truck driven by Michael Brimage, 53, Chicago.

The Behncke vehicle came to rest in the median, while the semi crossed the eastbound lanes and settled in the south ditch.

Brimage was not injured in the accident.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, Feb. 9 at 10:30 a.m. at Our Lady of the River Church in eClaire.
