

Alice Bieker, 87

OMAHA, NE - Alice Caroline Bieker was born to John Anton and Ruzena (Fucik) Masek of Ulysses, NE. During World War II, she worked at the Nebraska Ordinance Plant in Mead.

Alice died on Tuesday, May 25, 2010, at Methodist Hospital in Omaha, NE, having attained the age of eighty-seven years, eleven months, and three days.
