

Body found at Little George

HARLAN -- The body of a 42-year-old Dallas Center woman was found at Little George Lake here Monday, June 1 by two teenagers who had gone there to fish.

Sally Ann Bishop-Bennett was pronounced dead at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, the victim of a self-inflicted gunshot wound, Harlan Police reports indicate.

Reports said Bennett apparently drove her 1988 Volkswagon to the lake, located on South 12th St. in Harlan. The two teens, ages 19 and 17, traveled to the lake to fish at about 5:24 p.m. and found the body "laying on the ground." They immediately went for help.

Harlan Police indicate Bishop-Bennett died sometime between 3 p.m. and 5:20 p.m. that day.

Recovered from the scene was the vehicle and its contents, as well as a Taurus Model 66 .357 Magnum revolver.

Foul play is not expected. Family members were notified Monday evening. Funeral services are pending.
