Eugene Bladt, 86

AUDUBON – Eugene Jesse Bladt, the son of Nels and Christina Bertelsen Bladt, was born April 20, 1915, in Woodbury County, Sioux City, Leed's Section. Gene was baptized at his parents' home as an infant in Sioux City and confirmed at his parents' home by the Hamlin Lutheran pastor. He attended rural schools near Anita and Hamlin. He then was employed by several farmers. From 1935-1937, he was involved with the CCC Camp in Iron, AR. He then was employed as a truck driver for Sorensen Brothers.

Jan. 25, 1942, he married Laura Jeanne Miller in Fremont, NE. Later in January of 1942, he was inducted into the U.S. Army. During his tour of duty he was a drill sergeant in Texas. He was honorably discharged in November of 1945. He returned to the Audubon area. He was employed by the lowa Department of Transportation from 1946 until he retired in September of 1979. During retirement they traveled across the U.S.A. They lived in Hamlin until they moved into Audubon in October of 1998. He was an active member of the Hamlin Lutheran Church for many years, serving as Deacon and financial secretary, then transferred to Our Saviour's Lutheran Church in Audubon in June of 1986. He also served as the school director of Hamlin No. 2. He died Sept. 28, 2001, at the Audubon County Memorial Hospital at age 86 years, five months and eight days.
