In 1938 she received a 2-year teaching certificate from Dana College in Blair, NE. She attended the University of Nebraska School of Nursing and became a Registered Nurse in 1941. She returned to school and earned a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Dana College in 1971. She loved her career as a nurse. She worked as a nursing supervisor at the Orthopedic Hospital in Lincoln, NE and as a nursing instructor at University Hospital in Omaha. Later she was the Assistant Director of Nursing at the Nebraska Veterans Home in Grand Island.

Arlene married Dr. Ralph Blair on July 11, 1943 in Harlan, IA. His work took them to Seattle and Yakima in Washington and Broken Bow and Grand Island in Nebraska. They retired to Yountville, CA in 1985. After her husband's death she shared a home with her daughter in Napa, CA. Arlene was a member of the P.E.O. Sisterhood Chapter S Broken Bow, Chapter GP Grand Island, and Chapter BW St. Helena, CA. She was active in Eastern Star in Grand Island. She was also an active member at St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Napa where she served on the altar guild and was the founder and leader of the PIE Ministry for 11 years.

Arlene was preceded in death by her husband of 47 years, Ralph Blair, and her brother, James Christensen.
