Manning woman dies in autotruck accident

IRWIN -- A 65-year-old Manning woman died Wednesday, March 21 from injuries sustained in a car-semi accident on County Road M66 east of Irwin in Audubon County.

Iowa Highway Patrol officials said Judy Boersma was driving her vehicle southbound on County Road M66 at about 10:30 a.m. A semi-truck driven by Tony Kalin, 29, Caleridge, Neb. struck the Boersma vehicle.

State Patrol officials said the semi driver told authorities that

semi driver told authorities that the Boersma vehicle did not stop at the stop sign at the intersection, and the two vehicles collided. Boermsa was pronounced dead at

the scene.

The accident remains under investigation by the Iowa State Patrol. The Audubon County Sheriff's Office assisted.

Funeral services for Boersma were held Monday, March 26 at 10:30 a.m. at Faith Evangelical Free Church in Audubon with burial in the Manning Cemetery. She is survived by her parents, Dale and Dorothy Peck of Salina, Kan.; children Kevin Boersma of Manning, Molly Wilson of Eagle Grove and Nathan Boersma Lvndhurst, N.J.
