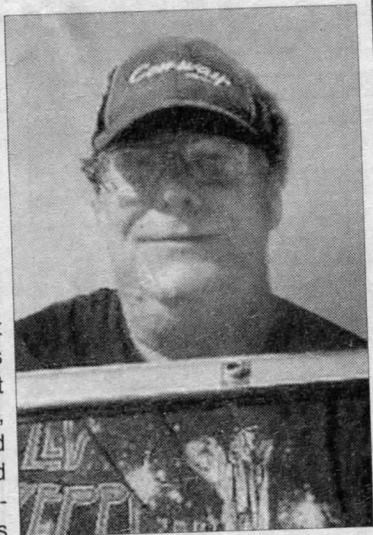


Randall Booth, 57**Jan. 5, 1957 - Nov. 4, 2014****WESTPHALIA** —
