## Harold "Jack" Borkowski, 80

Sept. 16, 1920 - May 10, 2001

MANNING - Harold Ernest "Jack", son of Otto F. and Emma Paulsen Borkowski, was born Sept. 16, 1920, on the family farm in Audubon County near Manning. As a young boy, his family moved to a farm north of Manning. He attended country school near his home. After completing his schooling, he worked for numerous farmers in the Manning area.

June 8, 1942, he married Evelyn Elene Weems at Maryville, MO. Shortly thereafter July 3, 1942, he enlisted in the United States Army and served as a truck driver in the Pacific Theatre during World War, II. He returned home Jan. 9, 1946, and he and Evelyn spent the next 27 years farming east of Botna. In 1973, they moved into Manning, and he began working for Puck Implement, retiring in 1985. Evelyn died Oct.

17, 1982.

Oct. 17, 1985, he married Alta Walker at Elk Point, SD. They made their home in Manning. From 1985 to 1994, they spent their winters in Texas. He was a lifetime member of the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars, participating with the Ceremonial Team. April 6, 2000, he became a resident of the Friendship Home in Audubon, where he died May 10, 2001, at age 80 years, seven months and 24 days.

Besides his parents and first wife, he was preceded in death by three brothers, Leroy, Clarence and Earl Borkowski; a sister, Mame Rostermundt; and a grandson, Jeff Williams.
