PARK RAPIDS, MN - Robert Arthur Boysen, son of Arthur and Mabel (McIntosh) Boysen, was born in Atlantic, Jan. 24, 1926. He lived in Corley, and attended school in Harlan, where he graduated in 1943. He entered the Navy and served in WW II from 1943-1947, working as a ship's engine technician.

June 26, 1948, he married Shirley Rattenborg in Harlan. The couple farmed near Avoca. In 1967, he started a seed and chemical business and in 1973, began an elevator business known as Bob Boysen & Son Elevators in Avoca. He died Jan. 14, 1998, at his Park Rapids, MN home at age 71 years, 11 months and 21 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents. Survivors include his wife, Shirley Boysen of Park Rapids, MN; four sons, H. James (Janice) Boysen of Shelby; Thomas (Nancy) Boysen of Co. Bluffs; Ronald (Peg) Boysen of Couderay, WI and Greg (Connie) Boysen of Harlan; two daughters, JoAnn (Steve) Schauer of Park Rapids, MN and Marsha (Brad) Larson of Sioux Center; one sister; 12 grandchildren and three step-grandchildren.
