PORTSMOUTH - Nicholas Anthony Bruck, son of William and Clara (Windehausen) Bruck was born October 2, 1916, in Earling, IA. On December 31, 1940, Nick married Alma Arkfeld at St. Patrick's Church in Honolulu, HI. March 9, 1946, after serving ten years, he received an honorable discharge from the Navy. He and Alma returned to Portsmouth and started farming and raising children. Nine children were born to this union: Nick, Ronald, Joyce, Robert, Richard, Joan, Jolene, Janet, and Randy. He died on December 28, 2007, at the Myrtue Medical Center in Harlan, Iowa, having attained the age of ninety-one years, two months, and twenty-six days.

In addition to his parents, Nick is preceded in death by his wife Alma, daughter Joyce, brothers Joe and Mike, and sister Rita.
