He also liked antique John Deere tractors Roscoe cared for a large garden, and tended many cattle and horses through the years. Roscoe H. Buck died on Thursday, May 8, 2008, at Creighton University Medical Center in Omaha, NE, having reached the age of 78 years, 2 months, and 13 days. Roscoe was preceded in death by his parents, Roscoe A. and Lillian K.
