HARLAN - Irene Vivian Buckner, the only child of John and Toracy (Petersen) Rasmussen, was born Dec. 30, 1915, on a farm near Jacksonville. After graduation from Harlan High School, she attended her first year of college at Dana College and then two years at lowa State University before graduating from Drake University in 1938. They resided on a farm near Jacksonville until 1970, when they retired and moved into Harlan. This has been her home since that time. From 1973 to 1977, they owned the Harlan Motel. She was a lifelong member of the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Jacksonville as well as the Hope Church Circle and knitting club.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her sons, an infant, David Dean Buckner in 1958 and Gregory John Buckner in 1976. She is survived by her husband, John Buckner of Harlan; her daughter, Candace (Dennis) George of West Des Moines, and two grandsons, Daniel and Eric, and other relatives.
