After Pete's death, she operated the family grocery business, worked as a cook at the Colonial Motor Inn, and as a desk clerk at the Super 8 motel. Ruth was active in the Amvet Auxiliary, the American Legion Auxiliary, Women's Fellowship, Music Parents, and served as a 4-H leader. She was a history buff and put together many scrapbooks, especially of World War II. She liked to listen to baseball games, sew, do embroidery, and different arts and crafts projects. She also enjoyed bingo and the social activities at the nursing home. Ruth died on Wednesday, January 20, 2010, at the Atlantic Nursing and Rehab Center in Atlantic having attained the age of ninety-three years, eleven months, and sixteen days.

Ruth was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, and her

brothers Glenn and Gaylord. She is survived by her son Larry Bussow and his wife Audrey of Hendersonville, TN; her daughter Carol and her husband John Humphrey of Walnut, Iowa; two grandchildren; three step-grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; five step-great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews; other family members and friends.
