She always liked her things just so. Her house was always very clean and the laundry was always pressed. She hardly ever sat down at night, she would set up her ironing board while watching TV, and iron everything, jeans, sheets, pillow cases ... if it got washed, it got ironed.

Every couple of years the interior walls of her home would get a fresh coat of paint. Many shocked looks on her sons' friends faces when they would come to the house and lean with their hand on the wall and she would scold them "get your hands off the walls." Soon they too would be trained not to touch the walls at her house.

Jan had many lifelong friends. Her and Jack always helped out where they could. They spent many weekends trading favors with friends. For them, this was often helping paint interior rooms or whole houses. She loved doing arts and crafts, and crocheting, making many beautiful things.

She loved her country music and she loved to go dancing and let loose a little too. They faithfully followed their favorite bands around to the local honkytonks and made many more friends along the way.

Jan passed away June 20, 2017. She was preceded in death by her parents and an infant sister, Patty Sue.
