

Lowell Campbell, 77

Nov. 24, 1918 - March 15, 1996

DENISON - Lowell Campbell, son of Milton and Martha Magnus Campbell, was born Nov. 24, 1918 on a farm near Defiance. He received his education in a rural school in Greeley Township and at Defiance High School.

Jan. 11, 1939 he married Neta Fretz and four children were born to this union. The couple made their home on a farm southeast of Dunlap for three years. They then moved to Defiance for six years before settling on a farm in Milford Township north of Denison. He died March 15, 1996 at the Carroll Health Center in Carroll at age 77.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Neta, June 20, 1992; one brother, Clifford, and a son-in-law, Marvin Woebke. Survivors include three daughters, Donna (Ron) Halla of Riverside, IL; Dorothy (Larry) Landgraf of Ida Grove; Joann Woebke of Denison; one son, Jerald (Debbie) Campbell of Denison; eleven grandchildren; three great grandchildren; one brother, Clarence (Nina) Campbell of Irwin and one sister-in-law, Thelma Campbell of Harlan.
