Oct. 24, 1915 - Oct. 27, 1995

Irwin - Ray Garold Conrad, son of William H. and Edith Sasse Pfeil Conrad, was born Oct. 24, 1915 at Manilla. He attended Manilla schools, graduating in 1934. He was baptized Sept. 6, 1933 and confirmed Dec. 15, 1957 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Irwin.

May 15, 1937 he married Maxine Dorothea Berndt at Shenandoah. Four children, Katherine Kay, Robert Kay, Garold Lynn and Harlow Gene, were born to this union. They lived on their farm near Irwin for 55 years. He was a farmer and a painter until retiring in 1979. They moved to Irwin in June of 1992. They celebrated their

Golden Anniversary in 1987. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Irwin. He died Oct. 27, 1995 at Manning General Hospital at age 80 years and 3 days.
