

Calvin "Ike" Campbell, 78

JAMESTOWN, NY - Calvin C. "Ike" Campbell was born in Shelby, graduating from the Shelby High School in 1938. He had lived in Jamestown since 1974. He was a franchise sales representative for the eastern United States for Central Tractor 20 years and for Tractor Supply Co. of Chicago for 24 1/2 years, retiring in 1990. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Company E of the "Red Bull" 34th Division. He was a member of the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Jamestown and was a life member of Robert P. Illig Chapter No. 47, Disabled American Veterans, and was a member of John W. Tiffany Post No. 53 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Girl Scouts of America.

He and his wife, Mary Alice ((Boom)) were married 52 years. He died at his home Aug. 17, 1998; at age 78.

Survivors include his wife, Mary Campbell; two daughters, Carol Lou Eisenhardt of Cheektowaga, NY and Carrie Wolfgang of Warren, PA; two sons, Bennie Campbell of Kansas City, MO and Kennie Campbell of Jamestown, PA; 10 grandchildren and two great grandsons.
