Campbell was born on September 6, 1944 to Floyd and Thelma (Pulver) Campbell in Walnut. He attended the Walnut schools and graduated with the Class of 1962. He enlisted in the United States Navy on September 8, 1965 and served as an electrical motor rewinder on the USS George W. Carver and the USS Briscoe. He was honorably discharged on September 30, 1985 as an Electricians Mate First Class.



Larry was married to Joan Collinson and had three children:

Wade, Robert, and Angela. He continued his work as an electrician at Greenfield Electric in Blairsburg after his military service. He moved to Fort Dodge and drove a truck for Keim Transport and later worked as a cable repair tech for Stratford Cable in Stratford. Larry liked to ride his motorcycle, go fishing and watch television. When he was with his friends, he liked to play cards, golf, and go bowling. Larry died on Saturday, October 19, 2013 at his residence, having attained the age of sixty-nine years, one month, and thirteen days.
