## Jack Carl, 80 ✓

*Sept. 9, 1924 - May 20, 2005*

**BEAVERTON, OR** — Jack Eugene Carl was born in Harlan Sept. 9, 1924. He grew up in Harlan. He was a three sport letterman at Harlan High School participating in football, basketball and track. One week after graduating from high school in May, 1942, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy to defend his country in World War II. He served his time in the Navy mainly in the Atlantic, Caribbean and Pacific. He returned briefly to Iowa upon receiving his honorable discharge in January, 1946, and worked for a mason. He left for Portland, OR, in late 1946 or 1947.

Jack married Verona Y. Lindroth Dec. 19, 1959. In August 1962, their son, Tom, was born. The family moved into a house in Beaverton in 1963, and this remained their home. Jack worked in the sales and grocery business before becoming a warehouseman for Bazaar. He continued in the warehouse business for most of his career. Jack died May 20, 2005, at age 80.

Jack's wife, Verona, and older brother, Victor, preceded him in death. He is survived by his son, Tom (Judy) of Portland, OR; and brother, Richard of Harlan.

A memorial service was held June 6, 2005, in Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church, Portland, OR. Burial was in Willamette National Cemetery in Portland, OR.
