

## Calogero "Bud" Caruso, 80

*Aug. 4, 1924 - April 29, 2005*

**CLINTON** — Calogero "Bud" Caruso was born Aug. 4, 1924, in Council Bluffs, to Anthony and Rose Marie Cuccia Caruso. He was a maintenance foreman for 33 years for the Union Pacific Railroad retiring in 1984. He had previously lived in Omaha and had lived in Shelby from 1984 to 2004 moving to Clinton one year ago.
