Sept. 8, 1920 - Oct. 4, 2006

KIMBALLTON — Edward Howard Christensen, son of Jens Peter and Cecelia Hyrup (Sornsen) Christensen, was born Sept. 8, 1920, on his parents' farm west of Kimballton. He was baptized and confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton. He attended rural school, Sharon #9, graduating from the eighth grade and then began working on the family farm.

March 3, 1945, Ed married Betty Biederman in Harlan. They made their home on the family farm. Three children, two daughters and one son, were born to this union. Ed farmed the home place with his brother, Raymond, until Raymond's retirement in 1978. After his wife died in 1998, Ed continued to farm with his son. When his health started to fail, he became a resident of Salem Lutheran Homes in Elk Horn in July of 2005. He died there Oct. 4, 2006, at age 86 years and 26 days.

Preceding Ed in death are his parents; wife, Betty; three sisters, Marie and husband, Hans Albertsen; Ada and husband, Vernon Miller; Tena and husband, Bennie Elmquist; two brothers, Raymond Christensen and a brother in infancy.
