

Lucille Cox, 81

Jan. 29, 1919 – March 7, 2000

CHEROKEE — Lucille Cox was born Jan. 29, 1919, in Cherokee County, to Lincoln and Leora (Stewart) Hahn. She graduated from Wilson High School in Cherokee in 1936.

She married John Cox Jan. 24, 1943, in rural Aurelia. She had worked for J.C. Penny Co. and for a department store in Syracuse, NY, for a short time. She had lived in Cherokee for the past 15 years. She and her husband had also lived in Harlan for 12 years, Fort Dodge for 2 years, Estherville for 1 year, and in Humboldt for 10 years. She was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Cherokee. She died March 7, 2000, at St. Luke's Medical Center in Sioux City, following a brief illness at age 81.

She was preceded in death by her parents; a daughter-in-law, Debbie Cox; a sister, Florence Bruce, and also a sister in infancy. She is survived by her husband, John, and one son, Galen Cox of Dike; two grandsons, Robert Cox (Gloria) of Holloman A.F.B., NM; Michael Cox (Kimberly) of Dyke; two great grandsons, Tanner and Jacob Cox; one brother and one sister, Gerald Hahn (Donna) of Cherokee and Charlene Peterson (Donald) of Aurelia; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
