

## Anna May Cullison, 94

Sept. 27, 1904 - Jan. 5, 1999

**HARLAN** - Anna May Cullison, daughter of George W. and Edith D. (Spencer) Romberg, was born Sept. 27, 1904, in Red Oak. She was raised in Red Oak and graduated from the Red Oak High School. She then attended Iowa State University and received her Bachelor of Science degree in Home Economics.

Sept. 16, 1927 she married George Bennett Cullison in Co. Bluffs. The couple made their home in Harlan where they raised their two sons and one daughter. She was a member of the Church of Christ Scientist, PEO, AAUW (American Association of University Women) and the Delphian Society. She had served on the board of directors for the Harlan Library. She died Jan. 5, 1999 at her home in Harlan at age 94 years, 3 months and 9 days.

Preceding Anna May in death were her parents, her husband, and one son, G. Bennett Cullison, Jr. Survivors include one son, Alan D. Cullison, and one daughter-in-law, Judith Cullison, both of West Hartford, CT, one daughter, Margaret Cullison of Moraga, CA, one sister, Virginia Davis of Arlington, VA, one brother, A.K. Romberg of Coronado, CA, nine grandchildren, two great-grandchildren and other relatives.
