Glen Cunningham, 77

Jan. 30, 1925 - Dec. 22, 2002

HARLAN – Glen Robert Cunningham, son of James and Eve (Haun) Cunningham, was born Jan. 30, 1925, in Dubuque. He was raised in the Dubuque area and attended school there. He entered the U.S. Army May 17, 1943, and served in the American Theatre, as well as Northern France, Rhineland, and Central Europe. After his discharge, Dec. 23, 1945, he began working as a truck driver, finishing his career by driving for Charles Furniture of Council Bluffs for 17 years. He retired in 1995.

Glen married Joan Ann Bennett. She died Oct. 30, 1985. He was a member of the Shelby County VFW Post #941. He died Dec. 22, 2002, at the Creighton University Medical Center in Omaha, NE, at age 77 years, 10 months and 22 days. He requested his body be donated to the Nebraska Anatomical Board in Omaha, NE.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his wife, Joan; two brothers, Donald Cunningham and Ralph Cunningham; and two sisters, Dorothy and Lorraine.
