On March 14, 1980, Larry was united in marriage to Deette Anderson at a family home near Lewis, and they were blessed with the birth of three children.

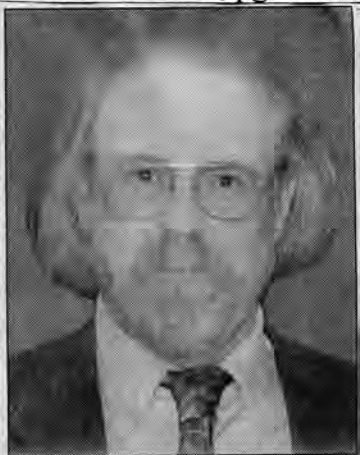
