HARLAN — Arlene Mildred Dahlof, daughter of James and Ella (Petersen) Dahlof was born March 21, 1914, on a farm in Polk Twp. near Kirkman. She was baptized in the Redline Church of Christ, and attended country school. She made her home with her parents, and on July 24, 1979, she became a resident of the Shelby County Care Facility, south of Harlan. This has been her home since that time. She died on June 4, 1992, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, at age 78 years, two months, and 14 days. She was a lifetime member of the Redline Church of Christ at Redline.
