WALNUT — Ed Martin Damgaard, son of Christian and Karen Nelson Damgaard, was born at his parents' home near Oakland on Dec. 20, 1897. He was the youngest of five children in the family.

He married Mabel Henricksen on May 29, 1923 at Atlantic. They farmed 180 acress south of Walnut, where he raised Belgian horses and Shorthorn cattle. Six sons were born to the couple. From 1946 until 1955 they also ran a restaurant called "The Annex" in Walnut. In 1967, they retired and moved to Walnut, where he gardened, raised flowers and tended a large yard. In 1983, they celebrated their 65th wedding anniver sary with a family dinner at a restaurant.

In Jan. of 1986, both were in failing health and they moved to the Independence care center at Independence to be closer to family members. He died Jan. 31, 1987 a age 89 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two sons, Merlyn and Dewayne in infancy; two sisters, Carrie Hess and Emma Hansen and two brothers, Hans and Mike.
