AVOCA — Edwin E. Doll, 77, of Avoca was born near Walnut, March 18, 1915. He attended school in Avoca and graduated in 1933. He attended Van Sant School of Business and began working for the Avoca State Bank in Avoca, where he worked for 52 years before his retirement. At the time of his retirement he was the Loan Officer and Director of the Bank. He served in the U.S. Air Corps during WWII. He served as an instructor teaching Navigation and Radar-Bombdiering. He was discharged as a First Lieutenant.

He served as the District Secretary for the Avoca School Board for 39 years, director of the Avoca Library for 27 years. He was presently serving as treasurer of the Avoca Historical Society and was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church and the American Legion Post #227. His wife Ethel died in 1986. He died suddenly, at his home in Avoca, Oct. 12, 1992, following an apparent heart attack.

Survivors are his wife, Genevieve Doll of Avoca; one daughter, Mrs Donald Cameron, Mountain View, CA.; 6 grandchildren; 3 sisters, Irene Liebert, Seattle, WA.; Ida Dunne, State College, PA.; and Clara Kessick, Stauton, VA.
