## **Sena Murray Drobaz, 73**

**IRWIN** – Aseneth "Sena" Mae Drobaz, the daughter of James Jay and Dora Pearl (Martindale) Murray, was born Feb. 12, 1916 on a farm near Irwin. She died at Irwin on July 21, 1989 at age 73 years, five months and nine days. "Sena" as everyone knew her, attended school at Jefferson Twp. No. 3 country school, and graduated from Harlan High School with the class of 1933. She was baptized at the United Methodist Church, North Hollywood, CA.

In Jan., 1941, she married Paul Drobaz in Yuma, AZ. She lived and worked in the San Fernando Valley area for many years. After retiring in 1981, she continued to live in CA. In 1989 she moved back to Iowa to make her home with her sister, Velma Newell of Irwin.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by four brothers, William, Dale, Earl "Pete" and Donald. She is survived by two sisters, Velma Newell of Irwin; Mable Hulsebus of Omaha, NE.; a sister-in-law, Edith Murray of Harlan; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held July 24, 1989 at Pauley Funeral Home, with Pastor Walter Bernard of Irwin United Methodist Church and Rev. George W. McMullen of Audubon United Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was in Arlington Heights cemetery, Audubon with Gary Murray, Walter Murray, Robert Murray, Larry Hulsebus, Kenneth Hulsebus and Kenneth Pedersen serving as casketbearers.
