## Robert "Mike" Dahlberg, 58 Jan. 14, 1954 - Sept. 9, 2012

Mike was a member of the Rosedale Covenant Church, where he served as church trustee for several years. He served as a member of the Lynch Public School Board, the Lynch Village Board, and also a member of the Lynch Volunteer Fire Department. Mike also enjoyed playing in card parties with his wife, being a member of bowling teams, and having coffee with the guys. In 2003, Mike fulfilled a long-time dream by building a home for his son, Jason, and his family near Madison, NE. In 2004, Mike and Terrie moved to Battle Creek, NE. During his time in Battle Creek, Mike fulfilled another dream of becoming a semi-truck driver. He worked for Foster Trucking Company until his illness forced his early retirement in 2011. While not driving and after the forced retirement Mike enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren. He attended all of his children's activities and enjoyed watching his grandchildren grow and used his love of construction and working with his hands to build many woodworking and crafts projects for his loved ones. Mike's courageous and hard fought battle with cancer was an inspiration to all who knew him. Mike was called to Heaven on Sunday, September 9, 2012, at the age of 58. He was the rock and foundation of his family, and will be greatly missed.
