Mick was a devout family man, he enjoyed spending time with his family and attending his children and grandchildren's activities. He enjoyed "scrimmaging" with his kids and grandkids. Mick was a truthful man who enjoyed life and who will be remembered by many as being quite the jokester. His sense of humor may be the reason why he was able to make friends with people so easily. He always seemed to know someone when traveling on vacation, but if he didn't already know someone, he would always have friends by the time he left. Mick died peacefully at home on Wednesday, March 13, 2013 having attained the age of 86 years, 5 months, and 22 days.
