

George W. Dickinson, 85

Feb. 14, 1914 – April 2, 1999

TOPEKA, KS – George W. Dickinson, 85, Topeka, KS, died April 2, 1999, at a Topeka hospital. He was born Feb. 14, 1914, in Hiawatha, KS.
