

Mildred B. Dinesen, 82

April 9, 1914 - Feb. 17, 1997

OVERTON, NV - Mildred B. Dinesen, daughter of Ed and Mary Romine, was born April 9, 1914, in Knoxville. She grew up in the Knoxville area and attended Knoxville High School.

Oct. 3, 1936, she married Marvin C. Dinesen, formerly of Harlan, in Tijuana, Mexico. During World War II, she went to work for a defense contractor as a machinist. After Melvin's discharge from the Merchant Marine Service, the couple owned and operated a motorcycle business in Oceanside and Bakersfield, CA, where she managed the books and parts sales. She was an avid lover of the outdoors, and greatly enjoyed riding motorcycles and fishing. She died Feb. 17, 1997, at Integrated Health Services in Las Vegas, NV, at age 82 years, 10 months and eight days.

Preceding her in death were her parents; two brothers, Cecil and Lester, and one sister, Vera. Survivors include her husband of 60 years, Melvin C. Dinesen of Overton, NV; two sisters, Sarah of Rock Island, IL and Winnie of Hemet, CA; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
