May 1, 1921 - Oct. 27, 2015

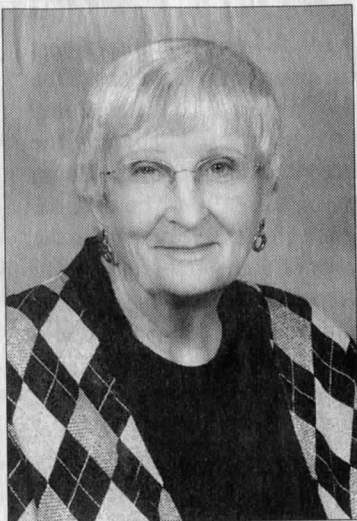
HARLAN — Nina Virginia Genco DePue was born on May 1, 1921 to Paul and Gertrude Belle (Hunefeld) Genco in Fort Dodge. She was baptized and confirmed at Riverside Methodist Church in Fort Dodge and graduated from Fort Dodge High School with the Class of 1939.

Nina worked as a secretary for the Webster County Assessor in Fort Dodge for many years and at Morningside College in Sioux City before relocating to Avoca. She retired as the Senior Aide Program Coordinator for West Central Development in 1995 and moved to Harlan in 2005.

Nina enjoyed crocheting, handicrafts, playing the piano and volunteering for many things. She was also a member of First United Methodist Church in Harlan.
