Harlan — Robert Calvin "Bud" Edwards, son of William and Myrtle (Maxwell) Edwards was born May 30, 1921, in Lenox. He was raised in Irwin, and graduated from Irwin High School in 1939. For 40 years, he worked as a farmhand for the Nordby family in the Irwin area. In 1980, he retired and moved to Harlan. He then moved to Little Flower Nursing Home in Earling in Nov. 1991. He always enjoyed bowling, and was active in area leagues. He died Feb. 14, 1994, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, at age 72 years, 8 months, and 15 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents and two sisters, Alice Kuntzweiler and Evelyn Speas. Survivors include two brothers, Max Edwards and Richard Edwards, both of Co. Bluffs, and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.

Funeral services were held Feb. 17, 1994, at Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan, with Rev. Aaron Jones presiding.
