## Feryle Fouts, 68

**IDA GROVE** – Feryle Beverly Fouts was born in Ida Grove, Dec. 31, 1920. She was the daughter of Raymond and Eva Mann Conard. She was one of three children in the family. She attended school in Ida Grove.

She married Kenneth Fouts on July 19, 1937 at Sioux City. They made their home in the Ida Grove and Battle Creek areas where Kenneth was engaged in farming until 1954, when they moved to Bellevue, NE., where they lived for seven years before returning to Ida Grove. In 1970, they moved to the Walnut area. They were the parents of four children. She was active in many community activities. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Walnut Garden Club and served two terms as president of the Walnut Community Club. The past several years, she has been serving as the Layton Township Clerk. She was also a member of the Rebecca Lodge in Ida Grove.

She died at the Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs at Nov. 7, 1989 at age 68 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents and survived by her husband, Kenneth; two daughters, Judy (James) Dickerson of Gretna, NE.; and Mrs Genie Fox of Bellevue, NE.; two sons, Kenneth Fouts, Jr. of Owensville, OH., and Robert Fouts of Loveland, CO.; ten grandchildren and two great-grandchildren; by one sister, Pat (Herbert) Wiegel of Lake View and one brother, William Conard of El Paso, TX., besides other relatives.

Funeral services will be held Nov. 11, 1989 at the First Presbyterian Church in Walnut. Graveside services were at the Ida Grove cemetery with Rev. Harvey Beach, officiating.
