HARLAN — Emerson Hayes Frampton, son of Hayes and Mary (Jensen) Frampton was born Sept. 21, 1923, on a farm near Corley in Shelby county. He died April 30, 1991, at the Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, at age 67 years, seven months, and nine days. After attending Harlan High School, he later graduated from the World Wide Auctioneer School in Mason City, Col. Frampton, as everyone knew him, has been a life-long resident of Shelby county, where he farmed near Corley with his father, and also worked as an auctioneer. Shortly after the death of his father in Aug. of 1957, he moved into Harlan, and this has been his home since that time. He became a member of the Bethel Baptist Church in Harlan, April 21, 1935.

In addition to his parents; he was preceded in death by a sister, Lotus Larsen; and a brother, Lowell Frampton. Surviving him is his brother, Jerome of Clear Lake; five nieces, four nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held May 3, 1991, at Pauley Funeral Home with Pastor Roger Crawford of Bethel Baptist Church in Harlan, officiating.
