March 25, 1906 - April 11, 1996

ATLANTIC - Arleene Frank, daughter of Walter L. and Edith Alene Eskew Boylan, was born March 25, 1906 on a farm south of Malvern. They moved to Hastings where she graduated from high school in 1924. The following year she attended Nebraska Wesleyan University at Lincoln, NE where she joined Sigma Alpha Iota, a music sorority. She later attended Iowa State Teachers College Summer School and Peru State Normal College. She taught a rural school near her home at Hastings for 2 years and then seventh grade for one year at Irwin.

She married Otto Henry Frank Aug. 15, 1928 at her parent's home in Hastings. Following marriage, they raised Purebred Angus cattle on their farm north of Irwin which were shown at numerous cattle shows including Chicago and Denver Stock Shows, winning numerous prizes. She was a member of the State Angus Auxiliary and held several offices in the organization as well as lifetime membership. She was a member of the Irwin Methodist Church where she belonged to U.M.W. She took part in activities of her church as well as the community. She died April 11, 1996 at the Heritage House in Atlantic where she was a resident.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband, Otto in 1984. Surviving are her daughter, Valda Lorraine Kennedy (Bob) of Atlantic; a son, Dr. Marlin D. Frank (Judy) of Greeley, CO; five grandchildren; four great grandchildren and several cousins.

Funeral services were held April 15, 1996 at the Roland Funeral Home with the Rev. Joseph Boysen of the Irwin United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Shenandoah. Casket bearers were Dick Clark, Mark Beeman, Rob Whriterour, Martin Kennedy, Matt Frank and John Eskew.
