

## Isabel Marie Feldman, 96

Dec. 11, 1921 - Sept. 29, 2018

**PANAMA** – Isabel Marie Feldman, daughter of Benedict Leonard and Mary Rosa (Kwapiszkeski) Blum, was born December 11, 1921 on a farm near Panama. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's of the Assumption Catholic Church in Panama, where she remained a lifetime member. In 1939 she graduated from St. Mary's Catholic High School in Panama. After high school she stayed to help her parents on the family farm.



On November 26, 1946, Isabel was united in marriage to Aloysius Joseph Feldman at St. Mary's of the Assumption Catholic Church in Panama. She and Al settled on a farm four miles northwest of Panama. Together they raised seven children.

Isabel was active in her community and church. She was a member of Catholic Daughters of America, the Altar Society and sang in the church choir. She was also a member of the Community Club, Legion Auxiliary and Panama Sewing Circle.

Isabel loved playing card games, bingo and especially playing the piano. She loved sewing, crocheting, embroidery work, and was an avid quilter. She also enjoyed gardening and bird watching. Most of all, she loved time spent with her family, children, and grandchildren.

Isabel died on September 29, 2018 surrounded by her loving family at her son's residence in Harlan, attaining the age of 96 years, nine months, and 18 days.

In addition to her parents, Isabel was preceded in death by her husband Al Feldman, granddaughter Abby Marie Feldman, brother Ralph Blum and sister Adeline May.
