

## **Lillian M. Feltych, 85**

*Aug. 5, 1914 – Dec. 21, 1999*

**HARLAN** – Lillian Mary Feltych, daughter of Charles and Anna (Kubes) Poduska, was born Aug. 5, 1914, in Chicago, IL. She graduated from high school in Chicago. She worked as a nurses aid, at United Air Lines and was a parish secretary at St. Pascal's Catholic Church.
