

Mary Ferrazzo, 79

Dec. 5, 1927 - Dec. 16, 2006

OMAHA, NE — Mary Lou Jacobsen Ferrazzo, the daughter of Leona Chandler Jacobsen and Henry Jacobsen, was born in Council Bluffs, Dec. 5, 1927. Her grade school years were spent near Hancock, where she was a baptized member of the Hancock United Methodist Church. As a young girl, she moved with her parents to Omaha, NE, where she attended North High School graduating with the class of 1945. Mary Lou then attended Beauty School and became a licensed beautician, working both in private shops and at a shop in her own home.

Mary Lou married Michael A. Ferrazzo Jan. 19, 1952, in Omaha, NE. They were the parents of one son, Jere. After working as a beautician until 1969, Mary Lou was employed as a color proofer by a Kodak film processing company in Omaha for 20 years, retiring in 1989. Michael died in 1982 and Mary Lou continued to make her home in Omaha. She died Dec. 16, 2006, at Methodist Hospital in Omaha, NE, at age 79 years and eleven days.

In addition to her husband, Mary Lou was preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by her son, Jere M. Ferrazzo (Kathleen); two granddaughters, Nina E. Ferrazzo and Alyssa R. Ferrazzo; her brother, Derill E. Jacobsen (Joan), all of Omaha, NE.
