

## ✓ Jacqueline Ferry, 84

Oct. 18, 1912 - April 5, 1997

**KIRKMAN** - Florence Jacqueline Ferry, daughter of Lewis and Della Hoffmaster Halloway, was born Oct. 18, 1912, in Greeley, NE. She was baptized in the Episcopal Church in Greeley, NE, moving to Iowa as a young girl where she graduated from Shelby High School in 1929.

March 3, 1930, she married Arthur William Ferry at Logan. To this union one daughter, Joan, was born. They lived all their married life in the Kirkman community, except for two years that they lived in Harlan. At one time she was the telephone operator in Kirkman. She was a member of Elk Horn Lutheran Church and of the church women in Elk Horn. She enjoyed camping, fishing and needlework. In later years she enjoyed reading. In 1991, she became a resident of the Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn, and it was there that she died April 5, 1997 at age 84 years, five months and 18 days.

In addition to her parents and her husband, Art, who died Dec. 12, 1973, she was preceded in death by her sister, Alice Chamberlain. She is survived by her daughter, Joan (Russell) Lange of Elk Horn; her grandchildren, Tim Lange (Pat) of Sibley; Bruce Lange (Darci) of Promise City; Lori (Paul) Maas of Palmer; nine great grandchildren; her sister-in-law, Mabelle Hayward of Manilla and other relatives.
