HARLAN — Carol Ann Foxhoven, daughter of Henry Michael and Frances Marie (Kaufman) Foxhoven, was born on August 13, 1947, in Earling. She grew up on the family farm near Earling. Carol was baptized and confirmed at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling and graduated from St. Joseph's Catholic High School with the class of '1965.
