WALNUT — Clyde Ivan Frahm was born on September 1, 1924 to Harry and Margaret (Wolf) Frahm on the farm northwest of Avoca. He was one of four children in the family. He attended country school and graduated from Harlan High School. Clyde was a farmer in the Avoca, Corley, Walnut and Elk Horn areas. He lived in Walnut with his brother Leroy and together they grew a large garden and enjoyed growing a lot of flowers. He and Leroy did a little canning of their garden produce. Clyde enjoyed fishing in Minnesota and Missouri. Clyde was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca. He moved to the Salem Lutheran Homes in Elk Horn in 2009 and this is where he died on Friday, March 7, 2014 having attained the age of eighty-nine years, six months, and six days.

Along with his parents, Clyde was preceded in death by two sisters, Virginia Piittmann and Leona Piittmann, and his brother, Leroy Frahm.
